
"I decided that if the universe brought me here and closed the door on financial crime investigation, it would open all the other windows to magical things - like the sound of making music, in the USA."

Karmine, inspired by their meet, transposed the final EP track the very next day. "I had written this poem on the train and I worked into a song, sent it to Joe and we knew - we had the foundations of a unique vibe."

Each track on the EP has its own story, written in a different phase of life, inspired by a unique moment and woven together by poetry.

A 5-track collective with each track title also being the line in the poem called - *Vertigo*.



Karmine's latest venture as the founder of Swartkat Studios is setting the stage for the creation of a global creative community and collaboration and production platform.
